



## **KI – BLUE BELL CAMPUS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **Location:**

#### **Where is the Blue Bell Campus Location?**

We are located at 1802 Skippack Pike,  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile west of the intersection of Routes 202 and 73.

#### **What type of space is it?**

We are renting space from St. John Lutheran Church. It is a lovely facility with bright open classrooms, a lot of open space, and a warm multi purpose room where we will be having services.

#### **Is KI looking for their own building?**

We have a home at St. John's for up to three years. We do hope to establish our own building with a preschool.

### **Religious School**

#### **When is Religious School?**

Religious School is held on Thursday afternoons. Kindergarten through third graders come from 4:00-5:30pm and fourth through sixth graders attend from 4:00-7:00pm with a break for pizza dinner. This year we are starting a new eLearning Hebrew program to give our students more one-on-one support and tutoring.

### **Programming**

#### **What does KI offer in Blue Bell?**

We offer monthly Shabbat pot luck dinners and services, religious school, adult education, family programming, and holiday celebrations.

#### **If I live in the northern suburbs can I come to things in Elkins Park?**

Yes, the Elkins Park and Blue Bell locations serve all our members.

#### **What is there be for families with children in Blue Bell?**

Many of our programs are geared toward families with young children. Our services include the KI puppets and are informal guitar led services with pot luck dinners. Holiday programs focus on activities for families with kids.

#### **What is there be for older adults in Blue Bell?**

We recognize that there are many adult communities in the Blue Bell area. Our rabbis are available for regular adult education classes and lectures during the week. We are also looking to develop programming for older adults as we become more established and understand what people are interested in.

#### **When is the first service in Blue Bell?**

Our first Shabbat is Friday night Sept. 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011. We will be having a dinner and service beginning at 6:00 PM.
