The essence of Michele Brody's work is the exploration of how we live with the constant flux of our environment. On its grounds and in the gallery of the Temple Judea Museum, Ms. Brody has created an interactive work of art that will evolve over the course of the exhibition and change the way visitors to the Museum see and think about the space of the gallery and its historic namesake, Congregation Temple Judea. "Entering from the Inside" represents the first time that an interpretive work of art - so directly resonant of this museum's unique place within its community - is brought to the public theater of the gallery space. The Temple Judea Museum welcomes Michele Brody as she brings to life her sense of "this place" within the multi-ethnic communities that geographically encompass the Museum and the old site of Temple Judea.
