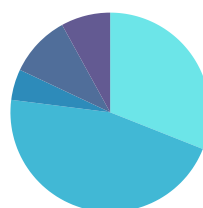
Association of Reform Zionists of America (ARZA): The Reform Movement's voice for promotion of Israel and Zionism worldwide.

Our annual budget is \$4,453,922

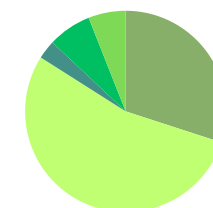
