To our HaMotzi Guests – A note with reference to “Best By” dates on grocery items and dented cans:

Some of the food in your food bags includes dented cans or close-dated “best by” dates. Please note that **these are not expiration dates**. The addition of these items has enabled us to increase the amount of food in your grocery bags.

We are grateful for a working relationship with the **Jenkintown Food Cupboard**. Through their contacts, we have been able to obtain quantities of various grocery shelf items (as well as food used in the preparation of meals). We also participate in monthly bulk distributions from Garden of Health, Inc., a warehouse in North Wales, PA, which receives food contributed by grocery stores and manufacturers. This food is then offered to dozens of food pantries throughout Montgomery County.

By going up to the warehouse, we have been able to return with items (such as 1,000 dozen eggs) to add to the significant amounts that HaMotzi purchases from local stores or receives from individual donations each month.

Our many volunteers work diligently to make a difference in your ability to receive food items. We look forward to our continued HaMotzi times together.
